# Educational Scholarship Fund 2009

**Requests for consideration must be received of postmarked by August 15, 2009.**

1. **Objective:** The objective of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to worthy students who have the potential to become future assets to the community.
2. **Eligibility Requirements:**
  - a. Any military Family member, traditional or non-traditional student, of an active duty Soldier, Reservist, National Guard in the Fort Campbell community, that will be attending a College or University in 2009/2010 may apply.
  - b. The only applicants who will not be eligible are: non-military applicants, OEN and CWE Board Members and their immediate families, i.e., Fathers, Mothers, Daughters, Sons, Husbands and Wives.
3. **Required Documentation:**
  - a. Letter of Acceptance on College or University Letterhead.
  - b. Transcript of school records (either high school or latest secondary school attended)
  - c. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation (not from a relative)
  - d. A typed Essay in which the applicant briefly discusses the following areas:
    - 1) The name of the secondary school the applicant plans to attend and why he/she decided on that particular school.
    - 2) How a higher education for the applicant can benefit our community.
    - 3) Career objective, both short and long term.
    - 4) Hobbies, Awards, Offices held, and personal accomplishments and achievements.
    - 5) Importance of financial assistance.
  - e. A small photo, preferably of the head and shoulders to be used for promotional materials if applicant is selected.
4. The major factors to be considered in the evaluation and rating of applicants will be eligibility, career objectives, academic records, financial need, personal letters and letters of recommendation.
5. OEN and CWE reserves the right to use selected student's photograph for promotional or advertising materials.
